The North Carolina Department of Public Safety (NCDPS) anticipates annual funds in the above stated amount will be available for programs serving delinquent and at-risk youth beginning on or after July 1, 2024. Local match rate for JCPC funds required: 10%.

Based on identified needed programs and possible gaps in the service continuum, the following program types will be considered for funding:

As a result of the Needs Assessment in the above named county, programs that reduce risk, address the needs of juveniles, and increase protective factors will be considered for funding.

Proposed services should address the following concerns as reported in the Youth Assessment Screening Instrument (YASI):

- o High Risk juveniles
- o Juveniles with High Moderate to Very High needs
- o Juveniles with Person Crimes and consequently assaultive behavior
- o Juveniles that displayed and/or used a weapon relative to their charged offense
- o Juveniles with family members with prior criminal as well as violent criminal history
- o Inadequate parental supervision
- o School behavior that leads to OSS and charges
- o Negative or delinquent peer associations influencing behavior
